JUDGING LIST CRITERIA

BREED SPECIALISTS

A1 List

Judges who have awarded CC's in the breed and have the support of the N&MCBC

A2 List

For persons who fulfil all the requirements for the A3 list and who have been assessed in accordance with Kennel Club requirements and accepted by the Kennel Club for inclusion on an A2 list and have the support of the N&MCBC.

A3 List

To have judged Beagles for a minimum of seven years, and have the support of the N&MCBC. To have been actively exhibiting in the breed for at least ten years and to have judged at least 40 classes with a minimum of 200 dogs present and judged, also to include at least one Breed Club show. Judging to have been over a wide geographical area. To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer, and passed the relevant examination on the Kennel Club Regulations and Judging Procedures. To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer on Conformation and Movement. To have attended a Conformation and Movement "Hands – On Assessment conducted by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer and passed the assessment (KC policy as of 1/7/05). To have attended at least one breed specific seminar run in accordance with the relevant Kennel Club Code of Best Practice and passed an examination and/or assessment. To be the owner or breeder of at least 3 dogs when they obtained their first entry in the KC Stud Book (save in exceptional circumstances). To have stewarded on at least twelve separate occasions to include Open and Championship shows.

B List

To have been actively exhibiting in the breed for at least seven years, and have the support of the N&MCBC. To have judged a minimum of 15 classes with a minimum of 45 dogs present and judged during a period of at least 3 years. To have stewarded at Open or Championship shows on at least six separate occasions.

C List

For aspirant judges who have shown an interest in the breed and have the support of the N&MCBC.

NON-BREED SPECIALISTS

A1 List

Judges who have awarded CCs in the breed and have the support of the N&MCBC.

A2 List

For persons who fulfil all the requirements for the A3 list and who have been assessed in accordance with Kennel Club requirements and accepted by the Kennel Club for inclusion on an A2 list and have the support of the N&MCBC.

A3 List

To have a minimum of seven years judging experience in any one breed, to have judged beagles for a minimum of five years, to have already awarded CCs preferably in at least one hound breed, and have the support of the N&MCBC. To have judged at least 40 classes of Beagles for a minimum of 200 dogs present and judged, to include at least one Breed Club show. Judging to have been over a wide geographical area. To have attended at least one breed specific judging seminar run in accordance with the relevant Kennel Club Code of Best Practice and passed an examination and/or assessment. To be the owner or breeder of at least 3 dogs when they obtained their first entry in the KC Stud Book (save in exceptional circumstances).

B List

To have actively judged for a minimum of seven years in any one breed, and have the support of the N&MCBC. To have judged a minimum of 15 classes of Beagles with a minimum of 45 dogs present and judged.

C List

For aspirant judges who have shown an interest in the breed and have the support of the N&MCBC.
