M. P.D 6 (1)

1, Coates Gladstyle Magic Moment: 8 months compact tri, with a clean outline, good head and expression, good reach of neck and well laid shoulder, level topline, moving soundly and freely, he was enjoying himself and showed a picture of a merry hound.

2, Goldberg’s Molesend Colt (Ai): 6 months rangier boy, with nice head and kind expression, well angulated shoulder, good spring of rib, moving freely.

3, Lewis’ Fallowfield Flyn.

1, Parker & Steven’s Serenaker George Gently: 11 months, super youngster, with excellent head and expression, good reach of neck & well laid shoulder, level topline, round bone and neat feet, good turn of stifle and hocks well let down, moving soundly with drive.

2, Toft’s Jarrowley Tolpuddle: 11 months, well balanced with good head and kind expression, level topline & quarters muscling up nicely, moving well with drive.

3, Theobold & Butters’ Evalux Druid of Breskar (Imp Ita)

J.D. 1

1, Parker & Steven’s Serenaker Armani, lovely example of the breed with all the essentials, excellent head and kind expression, good reach of neck and well angulated shoulder, level topline and well sprung ribs, round bone and neat feet, he is well balanced showed the correct movement in both directions & was a pleasure to watch going round. Yearling Dog 3

1, Bell-Thomas's Amorpapaver Jupiter, good head & kind expression, well balanced with good bone & spring of rib and level topline, hocks well let down, moving soundly.

2, Ferguson's Lillipaw Bruce The Spruce, well balanced with good head and expression, very fidgety so not showing himself to advantage, round bone, moving soundly.

3, Quinney-Spencer's Quincerhound Orion's Belt.

Beginners Dog 2 (1)

1, Ferguson's Lillipaw Douglas, happy hound with kind expression, good bone and spring of rib, moving well.

Novice Dog 2

1, Amorpapaver Jupiter.

2. Theobald & Butters Evalux Druid of Breskar (Imp Ita), well balanced puppy with good bone, kind expression, moving well he is a little proud of his stern.

Graduate Dog 2

1. Quinney-Spencer's Quincerhound Oreo Bark, quality well balanced hound with good bone correct shoulder placement and spring of rib, moving soundly.

2. Bridgman & Logue's Truewin Father To Son at Kingswin (Imp Ita), well balanced with good bone, level topline and angulation, unfortunately expression spoiled by too much wrinkle.

Post Graduate Dog. 5

1. Laughton's Brimbleway Saving Grace, very smart, good head with kind expression, round bone, good shoulders, well sprung ribs and muscular quarters, moving soundly with drive.

2. Coates & Coates Gladstyle Noah Fence, well balanced with well placed shoulder, excellent quarters and angulation, moving soundly.

3. Stoddard's Poppyville First Edition.

Mid Limit Dog 7

1. Foster & Jones' Stormpasture Rocketman, smart well balanced hound, maturing nicely with good bone, pleasing head and low set leathers, well sprung ribs and quarters showing muscle, good turn of stifle, held his topline on the move, and was sound both ways and reached well going round.

2. Woodcock & Woodcock's Molesend Verdict at Roddwood, quality hound with well balanced head and kind expression, good neck and shoulder, plenty of heart-room and well angulated quarters, moving soundly with drive, close decision.

3. Fraser & Fraser's Wyvisview Pinocchio.

Limit Dog 7.

1. Henningsson-Dundas & Henningsson-Dundas' Julemark Luther, stallion hound with good balance and substance, masculine head but with soft expression, round bone, correct shoulders, level topline, well sprung ribs and hard quarters. Moving soundly.

2. Ford's Cliffmere Mindful of Shercroft, another quality hound, well balanced and muscled, good bone, nice head with good reach of neck, moving well, close up to 1.

3. Caple's Morsefield Mudlark.

Open Dog 8

1. Craig's Ch. Davricard Jacob (Ai), meets the breed standard in every respect, a top quality hound showing balance, lovely head with dark eye and kind expression, his clean neck flows into well laid shoulders which lead the eye to his level topline, he has well sprung ribs reaching well back, excellent bone and neat feet, muscular quarters with well turned stifles and in hard condition, he moved true coming and going and reached out going round. An honour to judge him. C.C. My co judge agreed to award him B I S.

2. Parker & Stevens' Serenaker Hot As'ell. Another quality hound showing breed essentials, clean outline, well balanced head with well hung leathers, good shoulders and round bone, well muscled and moving soundly with drive.

3. Kingsland's Redcap The Patriot.

Goldberg & Goldberg's Ch Molesend Kaftan Jw Sh.cm, 9 yrs showing the qualities which earned him his title, typical head with soft expression, well set leathers, good spring of rib and level topline, good bone and well turned stifles, moved soundly and was enjoying his day.
